and hardly ever touch the ground!

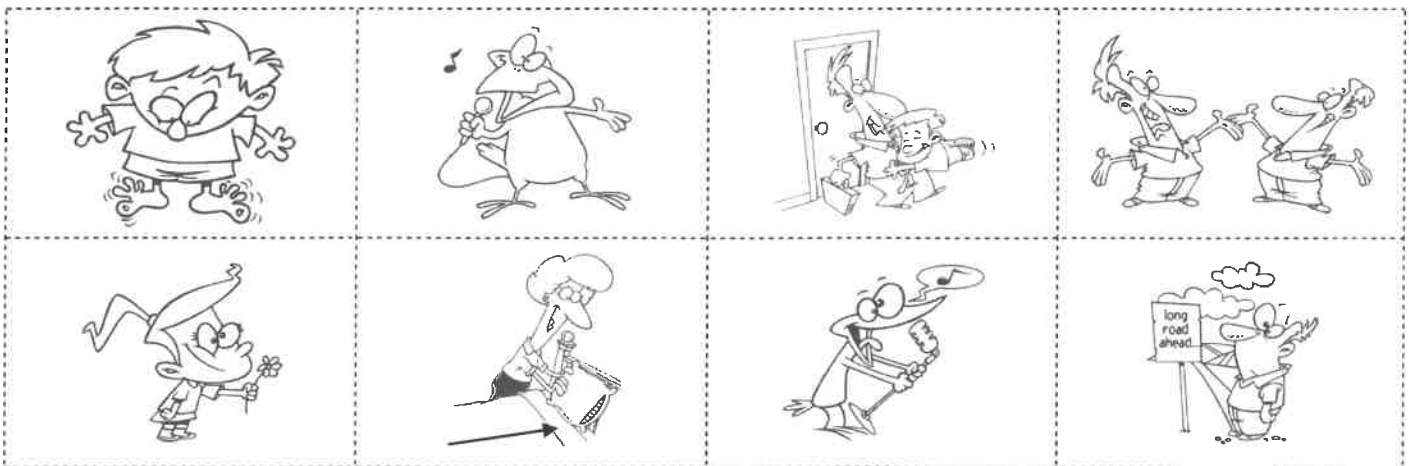
Some are young and some are new,
