when you are afloat!

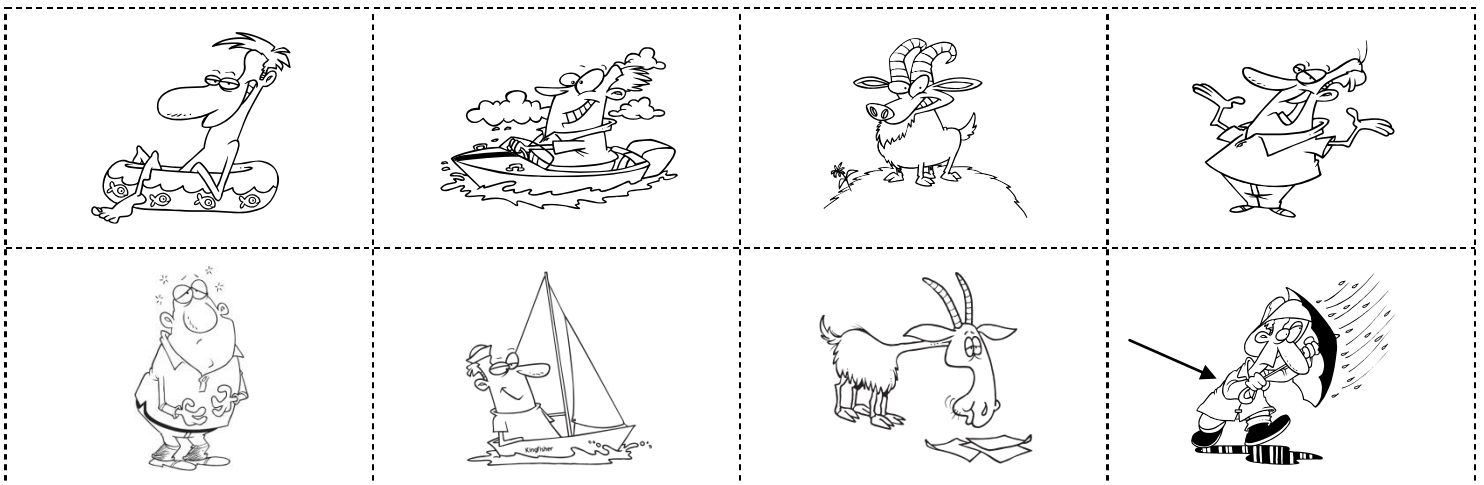
Watch that goofy goat

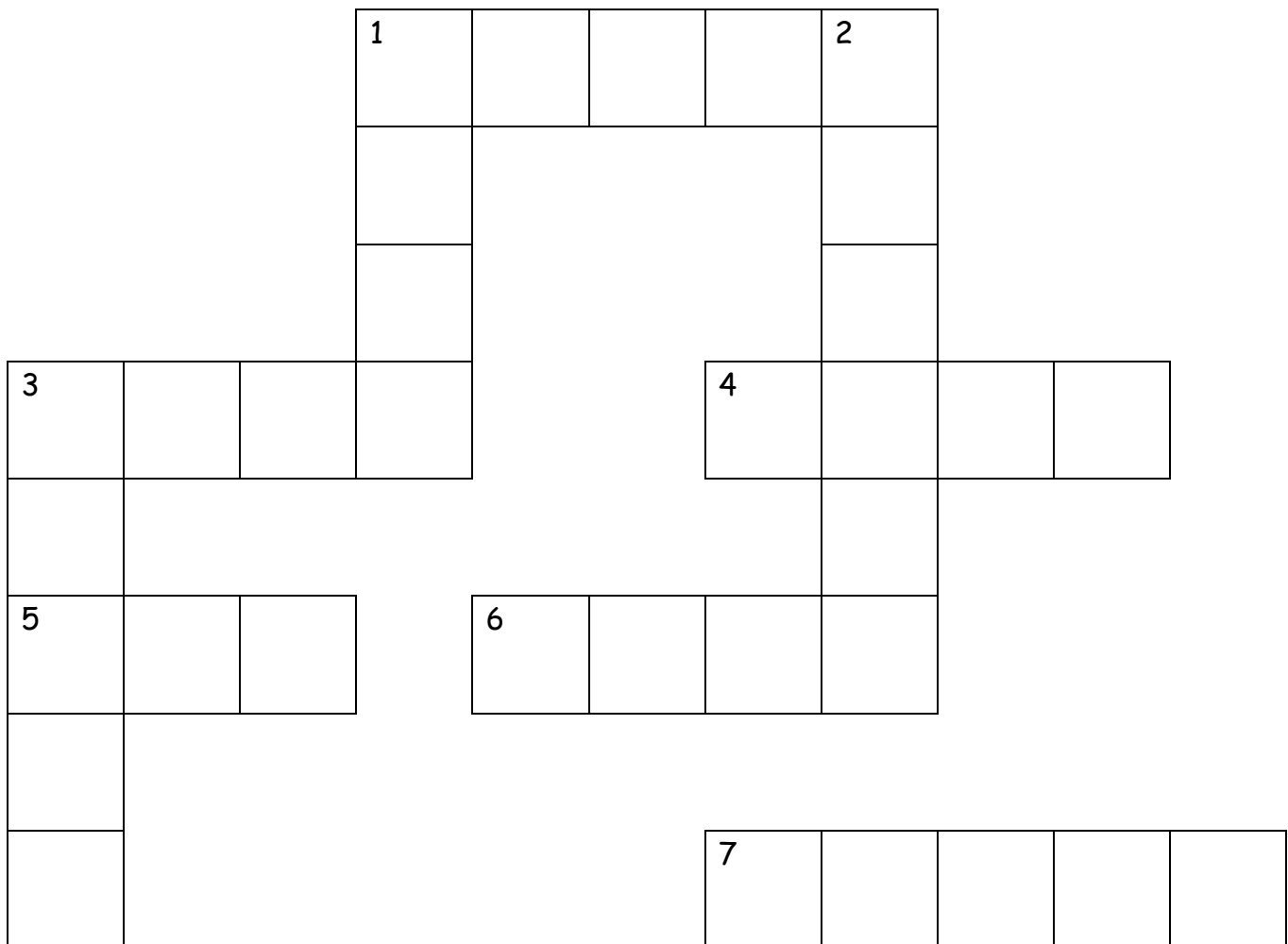
