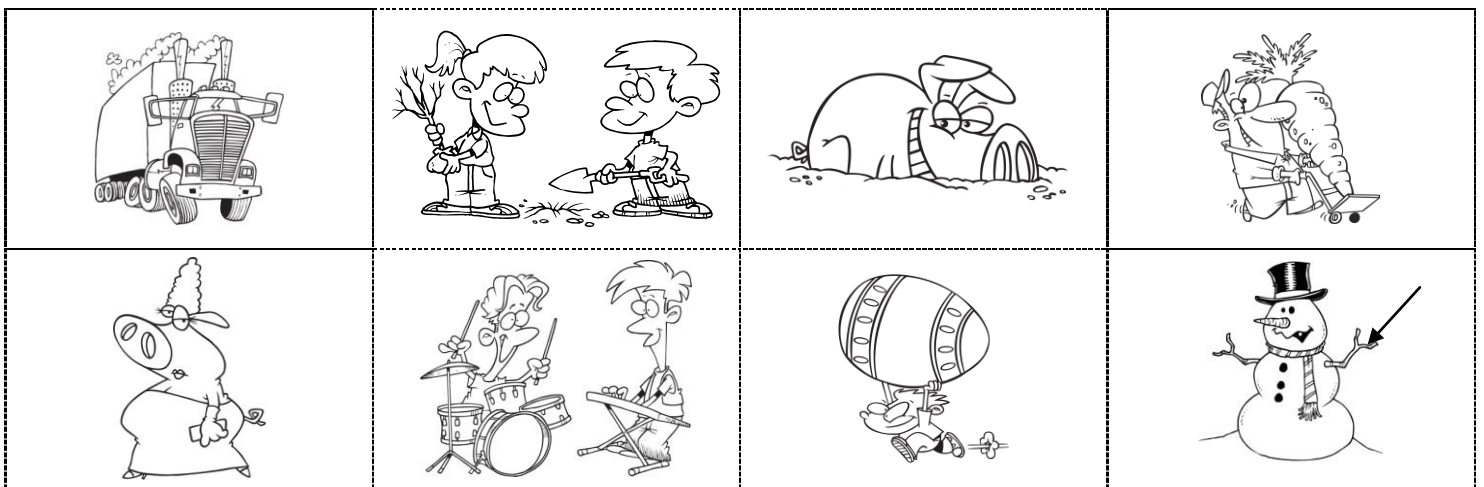
Farmer Grig has a pig

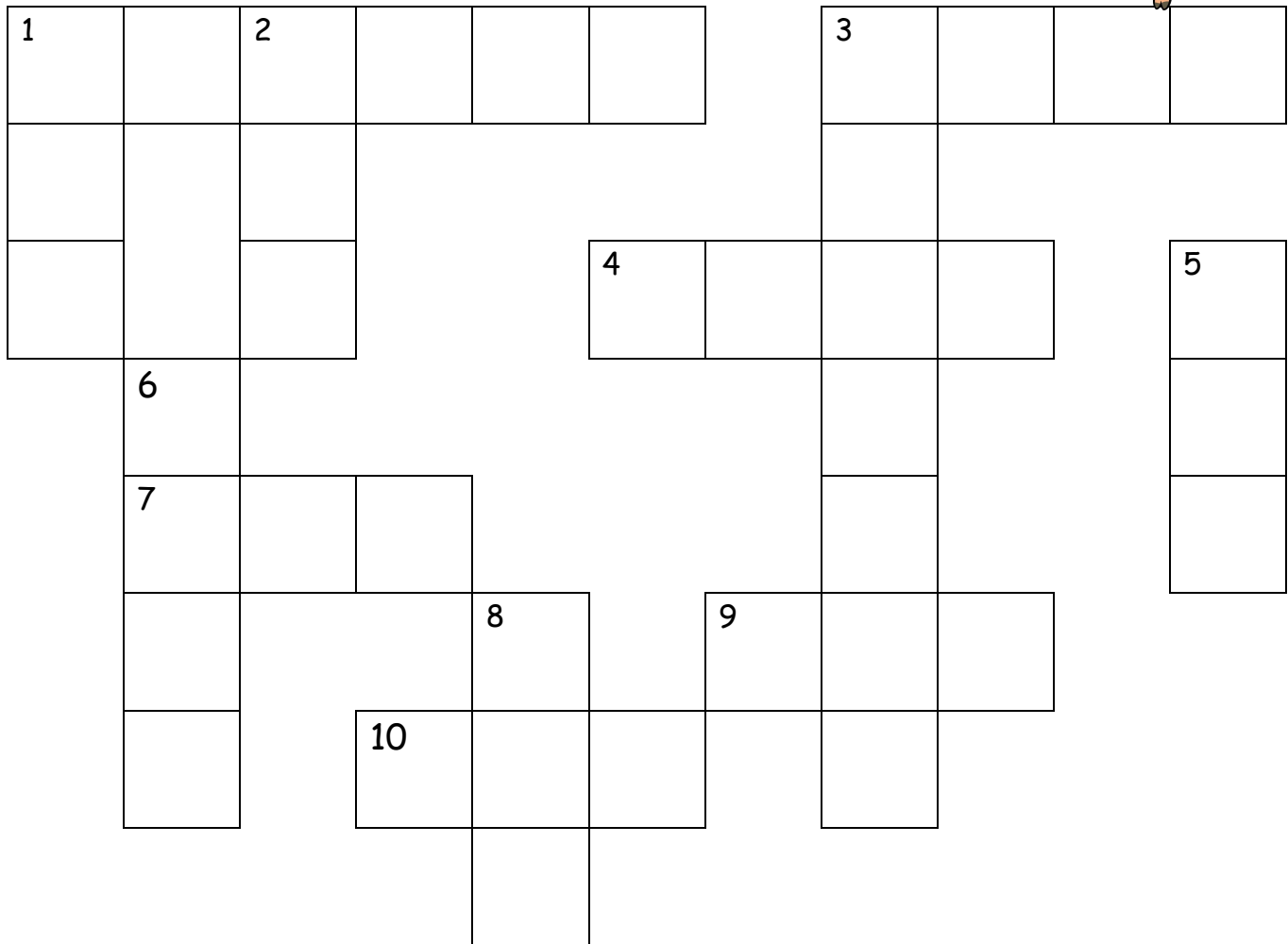

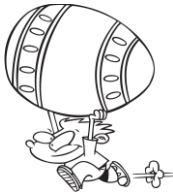

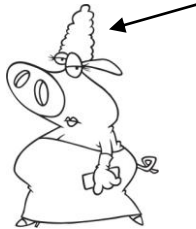
