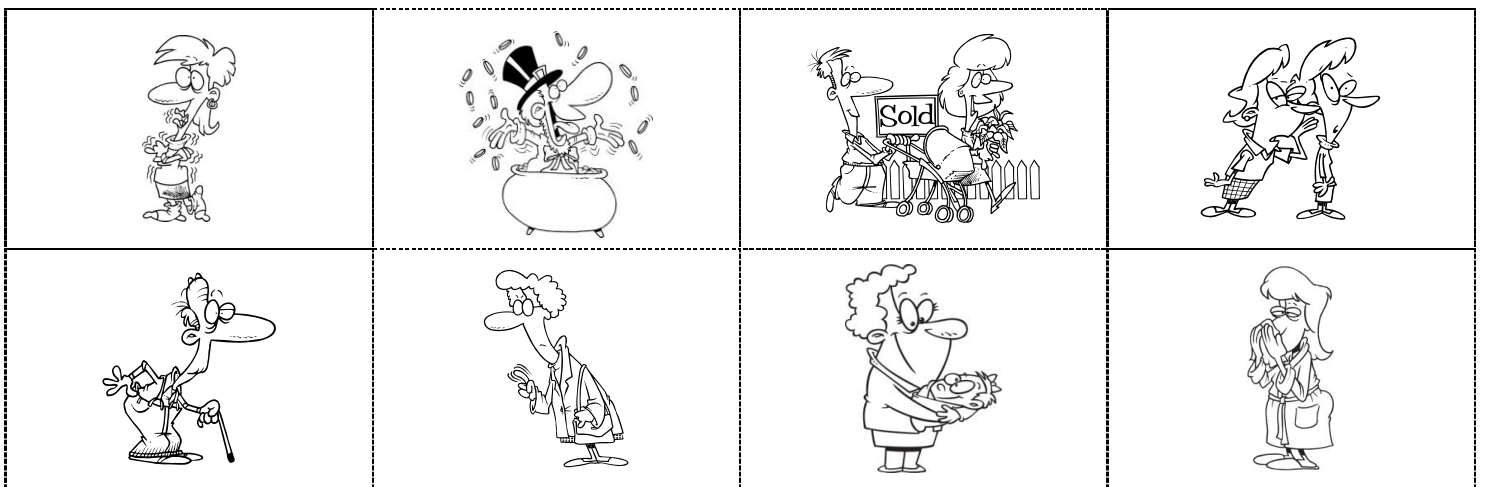
Some people say my grandma's old,
